Queries for 2009 onwards are handled through the **Forums** facility. A special Forum called ***O'Dea Genealogy Queries*** has been established to handle these queries.

2. Terms and Concepts

This section provides a definition of the terms and concepts used in this document.

2.1. Terms

Term	Definition
Anonymous User	A Web site user who is just visiting, i.e. a Guest.
O'Dea Clan Member	A user who has applied for membership of the O'Dea Clan and has paid the appropriate membership fee.
FAQ	FAQ is an acronym for "Frequently Asked Question(s)". The term refers to listed questions and answers, all supposed to be frequently asked in some context, and pertaining to a particular topic.
Forum	An Internet forum is a web application for holding discussions and posting user generated content. Internet forums are also commonly referred to as Web forums, message boards, discussion boards, (electronic) discussion groups, discussion forums, bulletin boards, fora (the Latin plural) or simply forums.
Help Desk	The Help Desk provides the users with a central point for help on various issues in using the Web site. The user notifies the help desk of his or her issue, and the system issues a Ticket that has details of the problem. This enables the Web site administrators to manage the issues through to resolution.
Home Page	The homepage (often written as home page) or main page is the front page, webserver directory index, or main web page of a website of a group, company, organisation, or individual.
Registered User	A user who has registered with the O'Dea Clan Web site by providing basic information including a userid and a valid e-mail address. There is no fee required.

3. What Functions are Available?

This section provides an outline of the functions available on the Genealogy Queries page.

3.1. Information Displayed

The information on the Genealogy Queries page is in three sections:

1. Queries for 2009 Onwards.
2. Queries from 2006 to 2008.
3. Queries from 2003 to 2005.

3.1.1. Queries for 2009 Onwards

Queries for 2009 onwards are handled through the **Forums** facility. A special Forum called **O'Dea Genealogy Queries** has been established to handle these queries.

3.1.2. Queries from 2006 to 2008

Queries for 2006 to 2008 will be found in the **Guestbook**. Access to the Guestbook is controlled through userid and password and is available to members of the Dysert O'Dea Clan Association only.

3.1.3. Queries from 2003 to 2005

Queries posted by members and friends of the Dysert O'Dea Clan Association during 2003 to 2005 were handled through the Clan Guestbook and Clan Forum. Those with significant family history content are published under these headings:

- 2005 Queries.
- 2004 Queries.
- 2003 Queries.

3.2. User Options

On the Genealogy Queries page, the user will be able to:

- Link to the **O'Dea Genealogy Queries** Forum for O'Dea genealogy queries from 2009 onwards.
- Link to the **Guestbook** for O'Dea genealogy queries posted between 2006 and 2008.
- Access O'Dea genealogy queries posted between 2003 and 2005.



4. Who Uses This Facility?

This section explains what particular user groups can and cannot do on the Genealogy Queries page.

4.1. User Groups

There are four main User Groups:

1. Anonymous Users.
2. Registered Users.
3. Financial Members.
4. Honorary Members.

Each Group has certain access rights to the set of Genealogy Queries.

4.2. Genealogy Queries Access Rights

The Actions available to a user will depend upon the permissions that have been defined for a particular User Group. These are shown in Table 3.

Read access to the O'Dea Genealogy Queries Forum for genealogy queries from 2009 onwards.	Yes	Yes	Yes

Read access to the Guestbook for O'Dea genealogy queries posted between 2006 and 2008.	No	No	Yes

Update access to O'Dea genealogy queries posted between 2003 and 2005.	No	No	No

5. When is This Facility Needed?

This section describes the situations where the user needs to make use of the Genealogy Queries page.

The Genealogy Queries page is needed when a user wishes to view the set of O'Dea genealogy queries and responses submitted between 2003 and 2008.

6. How Do I Use This Facility?

This section describes the steps required to perform each function available on the Genealogy Queries page.

6.1. Accessing the Genealogy Queries Page

To access the Genealogy Queries page, you simply select the **Genealogy Queries** item on the Main Menu.



6.2. Genealogy Queries Page

An example of the Genealogy Queries Page is shown in Figure 1.

From this page, the user has access to these options:

1. Link to the **O'Dea Genealogy Queries** Forum for O'Dea genealogy queries from 2009 onwards by selecting the **O'Dea Genealogy Queries** option.
2. Link to the **Guestbook** for O'Dea genealogy queries from 2006 to 2008 by selecting the **Guestbook** option.
3. Access O'Dea genealogy queries for 2005 by selecting the **2005 Queries** option.
4. Access O'Dea genealogy queries for 2004 by selecting the **2004 Queries** option.
5. Access O'Dea genealogy queries for 2003 by selecting the **2003 Queries** option.
6. Search the O'Dea genealogy queries for 2003 to 2005 using the search option.
