## ***Duke of Wellington***

*Trading ship, 366t William Collins, Hobart Town Tasmania for Isle of France.*

**1818** – Via Torres Strait, with ship “*Frederick*”, (Jn T. Williams), in company. Latter wrecked in Barrier Reef and survivors taken to Timor by *Duke of Wellington* plus Narritive by Mr White Ch. Off in the Sydney Gazette. Ref. No. 25.3.20

**1849** – Migrant ship, 56lt RM. Miller: London to Plymouth, c18.7 to Adelaide, 7.11: **Plus Memoirs of Michael O’Dea, including voyage.** Mortlock South Australia D 5235(L) plus papers etc re voyage in public records office South Australia ref GRG 35/48/1849

**1851** – Same as above – Voyage to Australia plus documents Mitchell Library Sydney document 3403

**1852** – Same as above – London to Sydney plus Society of Geologists Sydney ref Mitchell Library Sydney document 3403

**1854** – Same as above – London December to Adelaide. C11.4. plus Diary of C P Glover

**1855** – Mortlock South Australia D 5235 (L) and ref. PRG 310/19

**1852** – Schooner 87t W Pitcairn: Liverpool.10.9 – Madeira – Melbourne .27.1
